## Ash Wednesday Service Wed., March 5, noon & 6pm

Join us as we begin the season of Lent with an Ash Wednesday service at noon and 6:00pm. This is a short service where we commit to using the 40 days of Lent as

preparation to grow deeper in our walk with Christ. We spend a few moments in worship, have ashes placed on our foreheads as a sign of our mortality and dependence upon God for life, and we spend time in prayer.

What is Lent? Lent is a season of 40 days that begins on Ash Wednesday and lasts for 40 days. (The Sundays of Lent are not part of the 40 days of Lent and so remain "little Easters"). Lent is a time to prepare for Easter. It is a necessary prelude. The death and resurrection of Christ are true whether or not you prepare for Easter. However, without your heart and life being ready, you may not experience the depth and power of Christ's death and resurrection. Lent is not about being miserable or sad, but about preparing to celebrate the greatest news the world has ever received. Fasting and giving up something can be part of Lenten disciplines, but so can taking on some things. Click HERE for a few suggestions.
