# **Message from Pastor Jeff**

We are digging into Exodus 34:5-7 for the next few weeks in worship. If you'd like to go a bit deeper each week with a devotional, we put up a five-day devotional to go along with the sermon

When our church left the denomination we were a part of in 2020, we left a dysfunctional organization that we felt was more of a distraction to our ministry than a blessing to the mission of our church. It has been great to be free of that organization and we never want to go back into such an arrangement again.

My brother, Tommy, who also pastors a church that left the same denomination as we did, and I began shortly after leaving the denomination to discuss what it would look like to have a connection of churches that freely chose to associate with one another because we made each other better. We dreamed about a connection that was not bound together by legalities and rules, but by a shared sense of mission and theology. We dreamed of a connection that would be more about worship than workshops, relationships than rituals. and mission than maintenance. Something where we truly valued belonging over bureaucracy.

We dreamed of a connection where anyone could freely leave at any time, but that people wanted to stay in because it was a work of God and a witness to the unity of the church. (To read the full message from Jeff, click here)
