

Coping with Grief and Loss During the Holidays

The holiday season is often seen as a time of joy and celebration, a time to gather with loved ones, share meals, and create memories. However, for those who are grieving the loss of a loved one, the holidays can be a painful reminder of their absence. The emptiness that comes with loss can feel particularly heavy as we witness the festive spirit around us. If you are struggling with grief this season, know that you are not alone, and there are ways to find peace and comfort, even in the midst of sorrow.



Acknowledging Your Grief

The first step in coping with grief during the holidays is to acknowledge your emotions. It's okay to feel sadness, anger, or even numbness. Grief is a complex journey, and it doesn't follow a set timeline. The Bible offers comfort in this regard, reminding us that God sees our pain and is close to the brokenhearted. Psalm 34:18 says, "The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit." Remember, there is no right or wrong way to grieve. Allow yourself the space and grace to feel what you feel. Whether you need to cry, take a moment of solitude, or express your emotions with others, give yourself permission to grieve in your own way.
